# Journey of Hope Home

Changing the World, one child at a time.



**In Journey of Hope Home,** We started the year with 19 (pictured) children in the home but have had to release all but five to go back to their homes with their guardians. This is due to new stricter regulations by the government on the amount of time a child spends in a children's home. Most of our children have stayed in the home for quite some time and have grown to a point where we believe they will do well at home. We are still doing additional follow up visits to make sure they are settled in and well taken care of there. We will be taking in more children to Journey of Hope with time.

Our projects are also doing well. Currently we have around 4,000 laying hens which assist greatly in running the home without much need of funding from outside, in a month. Our garden is doing well producing green vegetables, maize, fruits and chia seeds for the whole neighborhood. Finally, our cow Muini is also producing enough milk to bring in a small income.

## Operation Hope

**Operation Hope is a program in ACMI that caters and cares for orphaned children due to the effects of HIV/AIDS.**

In the first half of 2018, we have added about 7 new sponsors to the program, We have paid school fees and have done visits for 170 children and are in the process of doing the same for term 2. We also had a camp in April with 100 of our children. Around five committed their life to Christ and many were uplifted as we played, sang, learned and ate with them.

We have seen a difference in the social and emotional development of our children. Many who were once quiet and unable to talk to us are now smiling and running to us when we come. We thank God for each one of them and the growth God has orchestrated in them.

# Chaplaincy Training

Our mission in chaplaincy training is to equip and empower Christian teachers with relevant skills through relevant and contextual training to meet the spiritual needs of students. 65 Christian teachers were trained in April 2018 at Makueni Boys High School. The following were the topics covered:
